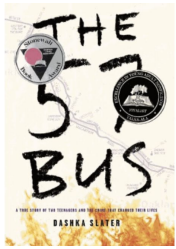


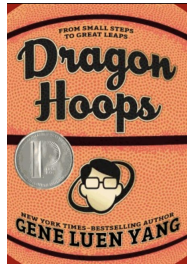

Rising 8th graders should read two books this summer. The choice is up to you, and these are some suggestions if you need ideas.

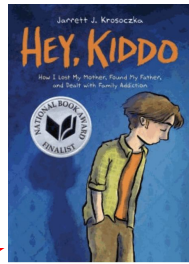
